



Job Title: Mathematics Specialist, Secondary

Job Description: We are seeking a highly qualified and motivated individual to join our team as a Mathematics Specialist specifically serving the 6-8 grade band, (6-12 is a plus). Due to the growing popularity of Illustrative Mathematics in WI, this person must already possess IM certification or have extensive experience with the Illustrative Mathematics curriculum.

The Mathematics Specialist is responsible for supporting districts with curriculum support/implementation as well as providing professional development and coaching support to teachers and districts. He/She may also assist in the assessment and evaluation of student learning and progress.

Position responsibilities will be diverse and include:

- Work with teachers to develop skills to deliver instruction that is aligned with their district's curriculum and state standards
- Assist with the selection and implementation of instructional materials and technology
- Collaborate with other math specialists and school leaders to ensure a cohesive and effective math program
- Design, develop, and deliver professional learning (content, instruction, assessment, leadership, and coaching) for middle and high school educators
- Collaborate/co-teach and/or model instruction with other educators to promote a positive and effective learning environment for all students
- Stay current with advances in mathematics education and incorporate this knowledge into instruction
- Seek and participate in continued learning opportunities for self, such as curricular resources, book studies, courses, and training
- Develop event descriptions and messaging to support the organization's social media/marketing efforts

Qualifications:

- Willingness to travel throughout Wisconsin and neighboring states
- Bachelor's degree in mathematics or education with an emphasis in mathematics
- Master's degree in mathematics education or a related field preferred
- Illustrative Mathematics certification required
- 3-5 years of experience teaching math in grades 6-8 or 6-12



- Strong understanding of the Common Core State Standards and Wisconsin Standards for Mathematics
- Experience with curriculum development and implementation
- Strong leadership, communication, and collaboration skills
- Ability to work independently and as part of a team
- Passion for teaching and learning
